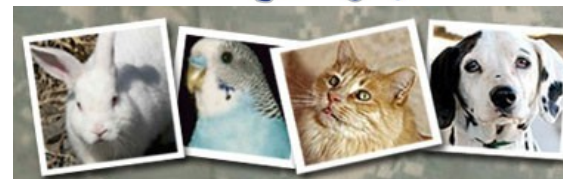

Background

Guardian Angels for Soldier's Pet (GASP) is an ALL volunteer 501c3 nonprofit military support organization founded for the primary purpose to support military service members and their pets impacting the pet owner's ability to retain legal pet ownership rights and preventing the unwanted surrender of their beloved pets to shelters or rescue groups as a result of the owner's deployment to harm's way (combat or peace-keeping mission) or unforeseen emergency situations.

We are a national grassroots organization with volunteers throughout the country dedicated to establishing a network of foster homes to care for these beloved pets until the pets can reunited with their owners, assisting military families with a deployed loved one, and veterans in emergency hardship pet related situations.

Programs

Foster Home Program

Foster home network throughout the United States available to provide a caring, loving, and safe environment for the beloved pets until the pets can be reunited with their owner following a deployment to harm's way or an unforeseen emergency hardship.

Military Pet Assistance

Financial resources to assist with pet related costs involving those pets fostered via our Foster Home program. Where funds are available financial assistance to military families with a deployed love one or veterans in an emergency hardship may be available.

Military Service Members

Our Foster Home program was created to assist our deploying (combat or peace-keeping mission) military service members who find themselves in the difficult circumstance of being unable to locate someone who is able or willing to care for the beloved pet(s) during such deployment.

This program allows our military to enter deployment without concern for their pets' welfare and be secure in the knowledge that they will be reunited upon their return home.

Military service members needing assistance due to a deployment to harm's way (combat or peace-keeping mission) should visit our website and click on "Submit A Pet" link to learn more about our Foster Home program.

Where possible please submit pet information at least 30-45 days prior to when you need your beloved pet(s) placed in a home. The more time we have, the better we are able to coordinate an ideal match, especially when working with multiple pets.

Requests for assistance due to an emergency hardship for military service members, families with a deployed loved one, and veterans will be addressed on a case-by-case basis as local resources allow. Please submit pet information and details pertaining to the emergency hardship via our website via the "Submit-A-Pet" link.
