2005 Financial Data

During 2005 we had one program, which was locating, interviewing, and monitoring foster homes for our military service members who were being deployed and had been unable to locate someone to provide a caring, loving, and safe environment for their deployed until their safe return from deployment.

Total donations received for 2005 were \$3,001 with total expenses of \$1,855 which was used for incorporating the organization, filing the IRS Application for Tax Exempt Status, spreading the word that our program/service was available to our military community and seeking individuals within the state of Arkansas who were willing to open their home to foster a pet or pets belonging to a military service member being deployed to fight the war on terror. At the end of 2005 our Net Assets totaled \$1,251
